ICFO Mentoring Program

The ICFO Mentoring Program connects late-stage PhD students and postdoctoral researchers with mentors working in a variety of professional environments, both within and beyond academia. The program aims to introduce participants to the full spectrum of career opportunities available after PhD or postdoctoral training while providing valuable guidance on career development and transitions.



How the program works

Registration

PhD students and postdocs can request a mentor by emailing mentoring@icfo.eu and completing a simple registration form designed to gather the necessary information for matching them with a suitable mentor.

If needed, the program coordinator will follow up with an informal conversation to discuss their goals and interests.

Identify mentors

Potential mentors will be selected from the ICFO Alumni community on a case-by-case basis

Pairing process

Mentor and mentee will be connected via email to start and follow the mentoring relationship

How the program works

Start

The mentee is responsible for reaching out to the mentor to schedule the first meeting, either in person or virtually.

Meetings

We recommend having at least three meetings within the first six months. Additional meetings can be scheduled as needed.

Follow-up

The program coordinator will always be available to provide support to both mentors and mentees if needed.
